**Christmas (Dec 25).** Please note there is no 6 pm Mass and catechism classes are cancelled on Dec 25.

**Feast of St. Stephen (Dec 26)**. Masses at 7 am, noon, and at 6 pm a Solemn Mass with Guild Ceremony. Reception for members of the Guild to follow in the parish hall.

The **Rosary for Priests** will be offered after the 8:30 am Mass on Sat, Dec 31.

**Octave of Christmas (Jan 1).** Normal Sunday schedule. *There will also be a fifteen decade Rosary, organized by the men of* 

the parish, at 3 pm, for the intention of the preservation of the Latin Mass, the success of the Marian procession, and Our Lady's protection over our parish.

Catechism classes are cancelled on Jan 1.

**Epiphany Water**. The Epiphany water blessing will be held on Thurs, Jan 5, after the 6 pm Mass, in the Church. Some notes, please read carefully:

- Water containers must be at least one gallon in size.
- Containers must be clearly labelled.
- Limit of two containers.

There is an unfortunate inclination among some of the faithful to look at Epiphany water as a kind of "super" holy water. Sadly, not a few priests have contributed to this idea. On the contrary, this blessed water should foster a real devotion to the mysteries of Epiphany, namely: the visit of the Magi, the baptism of Our Lord, and the first miracle of Our Lord – the changing of water into wine. Use it with devotion throughout the year to petition Our Lord's presence and protection be made manifest. And do please make every effort to attend Mass on Epiphany! God bless you.
