RESTORATION OF ALTAR CARDS

Two of our parishioners, Tom Scarry and Rachel Pineda, have worked to restore the altar cards that we use on a normal basis. Tom restored the backs of the cards, adding a red felt that has given the cards more gravitas and also serves to protect them as they are transported to and from the altar several times every day. Meanwhile, Rachel regilded the frames in gold.

Tom also constructed felt lined shelves for the sideboard in the side chapel, to store most of the altar cards of the parish and to keep them in good working order.

Finally, the cabinets in the alter server sacristy have been restored and re-painted. Several people have told me the dark paint (called *midnight oil*) is "not as bad as they thought it would be."
