PRINCIPAL FEASTS OF THE YEAR

Although not everyone has the opportunity to assist at Holy Mass every day, I thought it might be helpful to list out (very roughly) some of the principal Masses of the year, which might merit a special effort to attend. This is the result of taking a look at the table of precedence in the Roman Breviary, as well as just going through the Ordo for 2023-2024. The list is certainly not exhaustive; to it, we might add: feasts of saints to whom one has special devotion, or who serve as baptismal or confirmation patrons. Attending Mass on the anniversaries of important events – weddings, deaths of loved ones, Sacraments for immediate family – is also a very pious practice. I would very much encourage reviewing this list carefully, and entering pertinent feasts into whatever calendar system you use. This could be a very concrete step towards the practice of assisting at Holy Mass on weekdays at least a few days out of every month!

Note that I do not list out Sundays or Holy Days of Obligation here. The days here are listed in rough chronological order, not in any order of relative importance.

- 1. Epiphany (especially if you take Epiphany water!!)
- 2. Feb 2: Purification of the BVM (Candlemas)
- 3. Feb 22: Chair of Saint Peter
- 4. Ash Wednesday
- 5. Mar 7: St. Thomas Aquinas (*one of the FSSP patrons*)
- 6. Mar 21: St. Benedict (especially if you own St. Benedict medals!!)
- 7. Friday of Passiontide: Seven Sorrows the BVM
- 8. All of Holy Week, but especially the Sacred Triduum
- 9. Mar 25: Annunciation (especially if you have made the consecration according to St. Louis de Montfort!!)
- 10. May 3: Finding of the Holy Cross
- 11. May 4: St. Monica
- 12. Ascension Thursday
- 13. Vigil of Pentecost
- 14. Thursday after Trinity Sunday: Corpus Christi
- 15. Friday after the Octave of Corpus Christi: Most Sacred Heart of Jesus
- 16. May 31: Queenship of the BVM
- 17. Jun 24: Nativity of St. John the Baptist
- 18. Jun 29: Sts. Peter & Paul
- 19. Jul 1: Most Precious Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ
- 20. Jul 2: Visitation of the BVM
- 21. Jul 16: Our Lady of Mount Carmel (especially if you wear the Brown Scapular!!)
- 22. Jul 22: St. Mary Magdalene
- 23. Aug 1: St. Peter in Chains (particular feast of the FSSP)
- 24. Aug 3: Finding of the Relics of St. Stephen
- 25. Aug 6: Transfiguration

- 26. Aug 22: Immaculate Heart of Mary
- 27. Sept 8: Nativity of the BVM
- 28. Sept 12: Most Holy Name of the BVM
- 29. Sept 14: Exaltation of the Holy Cross
- 30. Sept 15: Seven Sorrow of the BVM
- 31. Sept 29: Dedication of St. Michael the Archangel
- 32. Oct 2: Guardian Angels
- 33. Oct 3: St. Therese of Lisieux
