PASTOR'S COLUMN

FR. MCWHIRTER

Dear Parishioners,

Come August, my assignment at St. Stephen's will be ending. I say this with a heavy heart. It has been the greatest blessing of my life to serve as your priest alongside Fr. Curtis and the other excellent priests with whom God has providentially placed me, not least Frs. Evaristus and Schwab. I want to take the opportunity sincerely to thank each of you for the thousand kindnesses you have shown me over the last four years, and to thank you also for so patiently bearing with my many shortcomings and inadequacies.

I am not actually being transferred to another parish, though I almost certainly would have been. For many years now, since the beginning of my time in seminary, I have developed a steadily growing desire for the monastic life. When I depart in August, I will be leaving to join the Benedictine monks in Norcia, Italy. I have the full permission of my superiors to do this, and it is in no way a departure from my vocation. I will still be exercising the priesthood, only I will be giving up the active care of souls in order to embrace the life of religious contemplation.

It is a great consolation amidst the sorrow of leaving to know that I will have ample time to pray for you all. I promise to do this, and I ask you also to pray for me.

Note from Fr. Curtis: I have had time to prepare myself for this since over a year ago when Fr. McWhirter approached me asking for permission to make an extended trip to Norcia, Italy, in order to discern with the Benedictines there, but the advanced knowledge has hardly made it any easier to lose him. As you know, he has been at the parish since the fateful summer of 2000, and he and I have worked side by side for the very challenging last four years. He is one of the finest priests I have ever known, mature beyond his years, and a very good friend. I am confident speaking for all of us that he will be sorely missed, but I am consoled that – though separated now by distance and circumstances – we will remain united in prayer, looking forward to that eternal home, which is not to be found on this earth.
