PASTOR'S COLUMN

SAINT EVARISTUS

St. Evaristus is the pope immediately following those mentioned in the Roman Canon at every Mass, i.e. *Linus, Cletus, Clement*. This would place him as the fifth pope, after St. Peter and these three men. He ruled over the Church from 100 to 108 AD, during the reign of the emperor Trajan. It is likely that St. Evaristus perished in the same sweeping persecution that claimed the life of St. Ignatius of Antioch, and it would have been to him principally that St. Ignatius addressed his *Epistle to the Romans* while on the way to his martyrdom. He is often depicted with a sword, as he died by decapitation, or with a crib, as he was born in Bethlehem.

His feastday is this Saturday; the day after the anniversary of his martyrdom.
