PASTOR'S COLUMN

BLESSING THE HOUR

St. John Vianney, the holy Curé of Ars, had a habit of praying constantly even from his early childhood. A beautiful devotion recounted in his biography is his habit of "Blessing the Hour." Every time he heard the bells strike the hour (think Big Ben in London), he would stop what he was doing, pray a Hail Mary, then say the following prayer:

"Blessed be God! Courage my soul! Time passes, eternity approaches. Let me live as I hope to die. Blessed be the Holy and Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of God!"

This is an excellent practice to follow. If you struggle with wasting time, this might be a good way to redeem that lost time. If you remind yourself every hour of those eternal truths, how much trouble can you get yourself in before the next hour comes? If you have a bit more time, this practice might give you a good excuse to continue praying and perhaps get in a Rosary or two.

There are other devotions we can do at various times throughout the day. The Angelus is prayed at 6am, Noon, and 6pm. 3pm is a special hour dedicated to the Passion of Our Lord.

In the words of St. Paul: "Pray without ceasing!"
