PASTOR'S COLUMN ANNUAL CATHOLIC APPEAL

This Sunday we are invited by Bishop Soto to support his Annual Catholic Appeal. The funds from this appeal are used by him to support his seminarians and also the poor.

As your pastor, I ask entreat and urge all parishioners to participate in the appeal, even if your contribution might be humble on account of financial difficulty. Bishop Soto has been extraordinarily supportive of our parish, especially in the last few very trying years. As recently as a couple of weeks ago, he took time away from his very busy schedule in order to dedicate an entire evening to a meal with the priests and our Apostolic Visitators. Before the meal, he met privately with the visitators for one hour. Later in the evening, he was so good as to assure me that he gave high praise and approbation to the priests and parishioners of St. Stephen's. This is very consistent with the kind of support, both in private and in public, that I have experienced from His Excellency during my almost nine years here in the Diocese.

The annual appeal is an opportunity for us to show our gratitude to His Excellency, a successor of the apostles, who carries the very heavy responsibility of answering to Our Lord for us. Although the funds are ultimately directed to various ministries, *the appeal is a donation to the Bishop himself*. I myself will be participating in the appeal.

NB. I delayed the appeal by one week to avoid confusion with the second collection for the building fund last week.

DEATH OF FR. JOSÉ MARÍA SALGADO, FSSP

Fr. José María Salgado, FSSP passed away on March 8, 2025 at 92 years old. He was ordained a priest for the Diocese of Stockton in 1993, but applied to join the FSSP in 1994, being definitively incardinated into the Fraternity in 2001. Since then, he has worked to develop our apostolates in Denver and Clarkdale. We will offer a **sung Requiem Mass with catafalque** for Fr. Salgado on **Monday, March 10 at 6 pm**.

MISSALS IN THE LOST & FOUND

I have placed a box in the parish office (specifically, in the conference room near the blessed items) for recovered hand Missals. There is a note in the Lost & Found area of the vestibule directing people there if they have, in fact, misplaced a Missal. I am told that people have been using Missals out of the Lost & Found as loaners <u>or even taking them home</u> (while the former is understandable but not ideal, the latter is bewildering). Missals are very expensive; their loss can represent a serious financial burden for families.

<u>*I*</u> insist that any hand Missals that have in fact been taken home be returned to the Lost & Found promptly</u>. Also, I suggest that everyone label the inside cover of their Missals with a name and contact information. Thank you.

EXPANSION OF THE DIVINE OFFICE

The priests will begin to offer, *ad experimentum*, the public Office on Saturdays, at 11:20 am (Sext) and 5 pm (Vespers & Compline). We have also added the Marian antiphon to the conclusion of all of the public hours. The faithful are invited to join in for the Marian antiphon; the current one is the *Ave Regina caelorum*, found in the hymnal on p. 188.

As the priests have a community meal after the evening Office on Saturday, the Church will be promptly locked after Compline.


