PASTOR'S COLUMN **RELIC OF THE HOLY CROSS**

After many years we have at last been able to authenticate a relic of the Holy Cross that was donated to me long ago by a generous Knight of the Holy Sepulcher. We will be securing the relic from the authenticator on Wednesday and we hope to make it available for veneration during Stations of the Cross on Good Friday (at 3 pm).

David fideli carmine, dicendo nationibus: regnavit a ligno Deus.

Impleta sunt quae concinit That which the prophet-king of old hath in mysterious verse foretold, is now accomplished, whilst we see God ruling the nations from a Tree.

NEW BOOKLETS FOR STATIONS

Last week I published new booklets for the Stations of the Cross, which were used for the first time last Friday. A few notes on their use: the Stabat Mater is sung when the bell is rung, during the procession into the sanctuary; it is doubled then and after the introductory prayers, again after the

seventh Station (the longer procession across the church allowing for this), and again before the concluding prayers. This gives opportunity for all of the verses of the hymn. The prayers in **bold print** are



designated for the faithful. After the concluding prayers, the celebrant will bless the faithful with a crucifix or (if available) a relic of the True Cross. The somber Attende Domine is sung by way of a recessional.

I am not sure of the author or origin of these Stations, but we have used them at the seminary for many, many years, where they are very popular.

TENEBRAE

If you have never been to the Tenebrae Divine Office, please consider doing so this year! The new schedule is partially to facilitate people attending these offices, which contain some of the most beautiful elements of Holy Week.

CONSTRUCTION ON HOLY THURSDAY



The INRI emblem on the main crucifix was dislodged during the veiling of the images, so we will be bringing in a knuckle boom lift on Holy Thursday (after the Mass) to repair it. The lift will return this summer to install a pulley system for

elevating a curtain over the cross in future years. There have been many other maintenance or capital improvements to the campus lately; I will try to update you on all of them soon. (Also, I am happy to announce we are moving forward very soon with the parish hall restrooms.)
